Dr. Mst. Arjina Akter, Associate Professor, Department of Plant Pathology who was granted study leave for the period from 01.07.2024 to 30.06.2026 under this office order No. Sec-2/A-2/2016/876/Estt. dated: 27.10.2024 is granted extension of his earned leave on full average pay for a further period of 1(one) month: from 01.07.2026 to 31.07.2026 to work as Postdoctoral researcher in the Kobe University Japan as mentioned below:

2. If she applies for leave/interruption while staying abroad while on leave and not joining the University service, the date of leave/interruption shall be fixed in her favor on the previous day of the last sanctioned leave i.e. her last working day in the University;

3. In case of breach of the conditions of the bond executed, the amount of salary allowance received/to be received during the period of educational leave shall be refundable from her with 15% simple interest. The period of employment during which there is no salary allowance in accordance with Government Decisions/Rules, leave shall not be counted as period of employment. That is, the period during which the appointing authority refunds/withdraws the salary allowances shall not be treated as pensionable service;

4. If, after joining the University as a self-employed person after joining the university as per the terms of the executed bond, she applies for voluntary retirement/interruption without completing the period for which he is committed to serve, in that case, the period he will serve shall be adjusted proportionately to her. The salary will be withdrawn from her and the pension case will be settled as per Government/University rules after determining her actual length of service accordingly;

5. Government service rules, pension rules, circulars, office orders, instructions and decisions issued by the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh from time to time adopted by the University shall be applicable;

6. If she does not return to the University in due course, the University authorities may recover her one-time pension and the entire amount of her status in the Provident Fund to compensate her outstanding bond. She will have no objection to it and her heirs in her absence will have no objection and objection will not be legally admissible;
